MATHUR & MUDGE CARRY MOMENTUM INTO MISSOURI TO WIN SECOND TITLE IN TWO WEEKS, 7th Nov, 2016

Five days after winning their partnership's maiden title at the Big Apple Open, Manek Mathur & Damien Mudge added a second title to their names Saturday—the 2016 St. Louis Open at the Racquet Club of St. Louis.

With fresh new world rankings of No. 2 and 1 respectively this month, Mathur & Mudge entered their third draw this season as the top seeds, but this time had two seeds and first-time partners John Russell & Viktor Berg opposing them in the draw.

The result marks Mathur's first St. Louis Open title, while Mudge augments his outstanding record of twelve titles. The Australian world No. 1 has now won the tournament with four different partners.
