## 2016 U.S. Junior Open Squash Championships at Connecticut, USA 20th December 2016

U.S. junior champion Andrew Douglas capped off his breakout year with his first U.S. Junior Open title, while Japan's Satomi Watanabe earned a fourth consecutive title in the girls' U19 division Tuesday at Yale University in New Haven, Connecticut.

The U.S. Junior Open, the largest individual junior tournament in the world, had a field of 889 players from thirty-four countries, six continents and twenty-two states. Four venues hosted the tournament on a combined forty-three courts at Yale, Trinity College, Wesleyan University and Choate Rosemary Hall.

Of the ten champions, four represented Team USA, two Egypt and one Japan, Mexico, England and India.

History was made when top seed 12 year old Shreyas Mehta became the 1st Indian to win Boy's Under -13 category after defeating Egypt's Islam Kouritam 11-4, 7-11, 11-6, 11-9.

## Delia Arnold has dropped a bombshell after announcing her retirement from professional squash.

The world No. 17 and national No. 2 tendered her resignation to the Squash Racquets Association of Malaysia (SRAM) director Mejar (Rtd) S. Maniam on Wednesday.

The 30-year-old who has been crowned national champion twice (2015 and 2016) will part ways with the national set-up immediately.

Delia who reached a career high world No. 12 in September 2015 will also pull out from the upcoming Tournament of Champions (TOC) in New York in which she was initially drawn to meet world No. 11 Sarah-Jane Perry of England in the first round.

Her last tournament was the Women's World Team Championship in Paris in which Malaysia could only finish a disappointing sixth.
